The documents needed when applying to the committee:

1. Copy of passport, and previous passports, and/or temporary Israeli ID
2. A certificate of honesty (no criminal background) from country of origin, translated and signed by a notary.
3. "Tamzit Rishum Murchav" from the ministry of interior, if the request comes from an Israeli resident.
4. A synopsis of life story, written in Hebrew.
5. A request to convert: Your connection to Jews and Judaism, motive for conversion, personal status: marriage, family, studies, friends and work.
6. Recommendations from Israel and abroad.
7. Two passport pictures.
8. The representatives of the committee may request more documents
9. When the request comes from an individual that resides outside Israel, more documents will be requested
